Please note the following:

1. Reservation forms are to be returned via the US Postal Service regular mail only.
2. Reservation forms postmarked prior to May 5, 2009 will NOT be accepted.
3. Reservation requests must be postmarked between **May 5, 2009** and **May 31, 2009**
4. The first **75** reservation requests with payment will be accepted.
5. **Please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope for confirmation.**

DIRECTION

From Rte. 3 South: Take exit 1C and follow signs to Scusset Beach.

From Rte. 195: After New Bedford and Wareham, turn right onto Rte. 25 East. Take third exit, just before Bourne Bridge (Rte. 6 Bourne.) Go halfway around the rotary to Rte 6 East toward Sagamore and follow signs to Scusset Beach.

From Rte. 495 South: Rte. 495 South becomes Rte. 25 take third exit, just before the Bourne Bridge (Rte. 6 Bourne.) Go halfway around the rotary to Rte. 6 East toward Sagamore and follow sign to Scusset Beach.

This rally is situated in a large open field next to the Cape Cod Canal. There is the ocean, with a beach; a 7 mile paved walking / bike / roller blade path right along the canal.
